

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017

Springfield Central State High School will receive **\$316,250***

This funding will be used to

- Maintain our focus on 100% of students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)
- Increase the % of Year 12 students achieving an OP 1-15 from 79% to 80% in 2017
- Increase the % of Year 9 students meeting NMS in reading or have an IEP from 92.5% to 100% in 2017
- Increase the % of Year 9 students meeting NMS in numeracy or have an IEP from 97.9% to 100% in 2017
- Increase the % of Year 7-10 students achieving A-C levels of achievement (LOA) across all subjects from 93.63% to 95% in 2017
- Increase the % of Year 11 and 12 students achieving A-C LOA across all subjects from 96.35% to 100% in 2017
- Increase the % of student attendance for Year 7-9 students from 92.8% to 95% in 2017
- Increase the % of student attendance for Year 10-12 students from 92.1% to 95% in 2017.

Our initiatives include

- Refine targeted and personalised individual case management of Year 11 and 12 students to ensure improvements in performance e.g. QCE attainment, LOA, OP 1-15 increase
- Identify at risk students using NAPLAN, subject results and school-wide Progressive Achievement Testing (PAT) to provide targeted and personalised learning for individual pathways
- Implement complex case management of Year 8 and Year 9 students at risk of not meeting NMS in reading and numeracy
- Implement intervention programs using:
 - Numeracy – Comprehensive Assessment of Mathematics Strategies (CAMS) and Strategies to Achieve Mathematics Skills (STAMS)
 - Literacy – Reading benchmarking and Levelled Literacy Intervention (LLI)
- Embed attendance case management and wellbeing initiatives into Year Level Coordinator roles and the attendance officer.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employing an administration officer for Senior Schooling to track student progress for Year 12 and Year 13 targets, and provide support around QCE attainment 	\$40,000
