Our initiatives include

- providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.
- undertaking coaching in pedagogy and data analysis from CogLearn with the Direct Instruction Program to deliver Corrective Reading and Corrective Maths program for selected year 7 and Year 8 students.
- supporting for transition from primary to junior secondary ensuring common teachers for core subjects, including additional literacy/ numeracy lesson in Yr 7 and 8.
- developing an interdisciplinary case management approach to supporting students at risk of leaving school before Year 12.
- strengthening the case management approach to students who are on a QCE or QCIA pathway.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- monitoring the performance of our students systematically and intervening when needed.
- providing evidence based support for all students.
- employing additional staff to provide support for all students.
